Haverford Reserve L.P., a joint venture of The Goldenberg Group and Pohlig Builders is pleased to provide this letter of recommendation on behalf of Allan A. Myers L.P.

Haverford Reserve L.P. entered into two contracts with Allan A. Myers L.P. to provide on and off site work for a total value of \$13,761,000. Both contracts were in connection with the 209 acre site of the former Haverford State Hospital. The work is part of the ongoing transformation of an abandoned site with twenty-six dilapidated and contaminated buildings into the finest new residential community on the Main Line with 100 elegant carriage houses and 196 sophisticated condominium residences. The residential portion of the site contains approximately 40 acres, with another 45 acres being developed as community recreational activities and the remaining 124 acres preserved as open space for passive recreation.

Offsite work included the signalization of the entrance to Haverford Reserve at Darby Road and associated road improvements as mandated by PennDOT.


