Dear Mr. John Beatty,

It is my understanding that American Infrastructure is bidding on one of your projects. Consider yourself blessed if you have such a professional, talented, organized and cooperative contractor on your site. Don't let this opportunity slip by!

Currently, American Infrastructure has been working on this forty acre site named Fort Evans Plaza in Leesburg, VA, since March of 2007. They were given the entire site package including clearing, excavation (ninety percent required blasting of every square yard), all utilities, cut and fill, building pads (nine buildings), curb and gutter, paving and paving markings of the main plaza plus and the expansion of Fort Evans Road to four lanes along with construction of the new four lane Battlefield Parkway Extension; contract sum in excess of \$13.5 million. Occasionally there have been disruption to the schedules by developer changes and permit delays; throughout these impacts American Infrastructure has been cooperative, flexible and accommodating to maintain the overall project due date. Their construction trailer is a model of organization with charts showing four week projections and where each crew will be working daily over that time frame. Change orders are clearly defined and fair. Their on site personnel are excellent to work with and the entire UCI staff have not met a single unpleasant manager, foreman and workman. They are collectively "team players".

I have been in the construction business since 1962 and this contractor is by far the best; therefore, recommended to our estimating department and upper echelon. American Infrastructure will mostly likely be on my next large project.
